Dear Community UCC,  
Several of you have called me regarding Elizabeth and the current Ebola outbreak in West Africa. Please

let me assure you Elizabeth is well and certainly well aware of the situation. The Ebola disease is not airborne. It is spread by coming in direct contact with body fluids of a contracted person or animal. She is aware of the symptoms (sudden fever, chills, vomiting, rash, a malfunction of the kidneys and/or liver and muscle weakness). The Center for Disease Control indicates the risk of contracting the disease is low if you are educated about it. You Elizabeth, weeks ago, she and her TU students from the College of Health Services and faculty set out to educate the community in cause and effort, prevention, hygiene, symptoms and the only solution to date, isolation and the need to be aware and careful.
